

Absentee Voting Ballot Guidelines
For Votes at Mid-Year Business Meeting
February 15, 2026

Voting for the 2026 Mid-Year Business Meeting may be done by 1) in-person attendance at the Meeting or 2) using this Absentee Ballot. If you received this Absentee Ballot mailed with the information packet about the February 15th Meeting addressed to you, you are an eligible voter. If you will not attend the in-person Meeting and wish to vote, complete the Ballot as instructed below and mail it so that it arrives **no later than Saturday, February 14.**

According to our Current Bylaws:

2. A vote on a question on an Absentee Ballot will become invalid if there is a successful amendment to the question. (In other words, if either the Proposed Budget or the Proposed Bylaws would be successfully amended at the Meeting, the Absentee Ballot (on that issue, at least) would be invalid.
